



# Product safety recall

## S-Mitter remote for cabinet and kitchen LED lighting systems

### Hettich Australia

Handheld remote control for cabinet and kitchen LED lighting systems. Affected product numbers: 3110701, 3111701, 3112501, 3116301



### Reason the product is recalled

The remote doesn't comply with the [mandatory standard for products containing button/coin batteries](#).

The battery isn't secured, and children could access the button/coin battery.

The remote is missing warning information about

- the dangers of button/coin batteries to children
- what to do when a person suspects someone has swallowed or placed a button/coin battery inside any part of their body.

### The hazards to consumers

Children are at risk of choking, severe internal burn injuries or death if they swallow or place button/coin batteries inside their bodies.

Serious injury can occur in as little as 2 hours and the results can be fatal. In Australia, children have suffered serious injuries or died from swallowing button/coin batteries.

If you suspect a child has swallowed or inserted a button/coin battery:

- **Call Triple Zero (000)** if a child is having any difficulty breathing.
- Call the Poisons Information Centre immediately on 13 11 26, available 24 hours a day. They can direct you to an appropriate medical facility.

Early action can save lives. Do not wait for symptoms to develop.

### What consumers should do

1. Stop using the remote immediately and place out of reach of children.
2. Return the remote to Hettich or the place of purchase for a free replacement with a compliant remote.
